tour, where only limited access is possible.

Funding Problems Ahead.....

The government cut backs have had an immediate impact on our club.

Since April 2009 we have raised grants totaling over £8k The bulk of our funding has come from Hillingdon Sports Council and the Grass Roots Foundation. However, we have been informed that beyond March 2011 we will not be receiving financial support from either of these organisations.

Hillingdon Sports Council provided the financial support

for our gala mini-bus transport. This costs about £800 a year and enables club members to participate in the gala team programme.

Grass Roots (NWLFC) has provided £950 p.a supporting the transport cost for our outings allowing us to provide specialist coaches.

We will try to approach other organisations for support but the current environment is very tough and there are many others chasing for support so fundraising is

proving to be very competitive. If you know of any organisations / funders that would be willing to step in to support or partially support our two financial problems please let one of the committee members know.

The club has limited funds and so it is unlikely that we can continue with the same level of activity without external help.

So any help would be appreciated!

In case you were wondering why.....

.....we are not holding back some of the Grass Roots Funding for the future.....

well we would have preferred to have done just that, but the terms of our grant make clear that we must use the funds by no later than 31/3/2011 otherwise we are required to return any unspent balance.

Hence, we scheduled the Cadbury World outing for 27th March, shortly ahead of

the closing of the Fund.

We are very grateful to the Grass Roots Organisation (Managed locally by the North West London Community Foundation) because with their help we have provided transport to: Cotswolds Wildlife Park;; Longleat House and Safari Park; Cadbury World; 2 Summer Lunches (Marlow and White Waltham) and 2 evening Meals (Iver

Heath).

So please take advantage of the remaining events covered by the Grass Roots grant and book for the Cadbury World Outing Sunday March 27th and also if you require transport to the evening meal please book early for a seat on the mini-bus.

Thank you to everyone who participated in the pool evacuation on November 20th. It is important for your safety that we carry out these drills so that you all know what to do in the event of an emergency. It is also useful for the lifeguards experience an evacuation involving disabled swimmers as part of their training.

However, we do apologise for the inconvenience that the drills cause you all, but we try to keep the disruption to a minimum.

Just a reminder that children and/or vulnerable adults should always be supervised in the changing rooms. We also require your help to ensure that children and vulnerable members do not return to the changing rooms unaccompanied during the Saturday sessions or at gasal.

Join the A40 heading west
 Leave the A40 at the Denham Roundabout
 At the roundabout take the 2nd exit A412 (Denham Road)
 Continue for 1 mile until the roundabout and take first exit onto Bangors Road North (0.3 mls)
 At the next roundabout take the first exit Bangors Road North (0.2 mls)
 Bear left onto Bangors Road South (0.1 mls)
 At the roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Slough Road (A4007) (0.1 mls to location)
 The Black Horse is on the junction with Slough Road on the right
