NASCH RULES FOR DOLPHIN SWIMMING CLUB GALAS

- 1. Each club may enter 1 swimmer per individual event and 1 team per relay.
- 2. All events will be freestyle.
- 3. Swimming aids may be worn.
- 4. Competitors for junior events will be under 21 years of age on the day of the gala.
- 5. Handicapping will be on a time basis.
- 6. A 5% repositioning factor shall apply, i.e. any swimmer whose time is faster than his submitted time by more than 5% of the average submitted times for all the swimmers in that event shall be repositioned.
- 7. In the interest of safety, all starts shall be in the water.
- 8. A competitor will be disqualified if
 - a) he leaves the starting line before his "Go" time unless he returns and touches the wall before restarting.
 - b) there is any physical contact with an accompanying swimmer once the competitor has left the poolside until he has touched the wall at the end of the race.
 - c) an accompanying swimmer swims ahead of the competitor or swims into an adjacent lane.
 - d) he uses the lane ropes, pool side or railings to assist his progress.
 - e) in a relay, he loses contact with the poolside before the preceding swimmer has touched the end of the pool.

The System is simple and has been designed to give every handicapped person the opportunity to swim competitively with an equal chance to win. The System does not discriminate between physically and mentally handicapped people, nor indeed does it discriminate between types of physical handicap or performance (speed) of swimmers and using this System the most severely handicapped people can compete on equal terms with those who have a slight handicap and may be much faster swimmers. It follows of course that by using this System both handicapped and non-handicapped people could compete together on equal terms.
